Effective December 3, 2024, Consolidated is modifying Shared Use/Mixed Use. Changes to FCC Access Tariffs Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9 will be filed at the FCC under Transmittal No. 129. Business Data Services (BDS) Service Guides 1, 2, 3 and 4 will also be modified to reflect this change.

A Shared Use/Mixed Use facility will be ordered, provisioned and rated only as Special Access Service, regardless of whether individual channels of the Shared Use/Mixed Use facility are used for Special Access Service, Switched Access Service, or any other type of service. The practice known as ratcheting (to apply non-Special Access rates on a proportional basis) shall not apply in any circumstance. Further terms and conditions apply as set forth in the above-referenced revisions to the FCC tariffs and BDS Service Guides.
